After breakfast, its 2 hours drive via NH21 to Dholpur for **Chambal River Safari.** Chambal River Safari is the breeding site of Indian Skimmer. It open Monday through Sunday from 10 AM to 3 PM. The safari is led by a naturalist guide and includes lunch, water, soft drinks, and views of the surroundings. You can spot local creatures like **Crocodiles, Turtles, & Birds,** (The sanctuary is closed for safaris from July to September due to the monsoons.) in Evening, Return to Agra.





SOOR SAROVAR BIRD SANCTUARY (DAY TOUR)

After breakfast, drive 57 min (55.3 km) via to visit **Sur Sarovar Bird Sanctuary & Bear Rescue Facility,** it covers an area of roughly 8 sq km, of which the lake comprises 2.25 sq km. The area provides shelter to nearly two dozen species of migratory as well as resident birds. timings 8 AM TO 6 PM. Sur Sarovar Bird Sanctuary open Monday through Sunday.

ETAWAH LION SAFARI (DAY TOUR)


